

**Memorandum Concerning Kyunghee University
Summer Training Program to be held at the
State University of New York at Stony Brook**

Kyunghee University (hereafter referred to as KU) and the State University of New York at Stony Brook (hereafter referred to as SBU) confirm the following:

1. SBU will administer a summer training program for KU as agreed from July 14 (arrival) until July 27 (departure), 2019. KU students will be provided with on-campus accommodation from July 14 - 27, 2019, and group transportation to and from the JFK International Airport on arrival and departure days.
2. English Instruction: Students will receive approximately 29 hours of English language instruction as part of SBU's 2019 Global Summer Institute Global Certificate Program. Instruction hours are detailed below.

Monday - Thursday 9:00am - 12:00pm
Special Lectures 1:00pm - 2:30pm (July 18, 22, and 24)

3. Clinical Dental Observation: Students will receive 12 hours total of clinical observation at SBU's School of Dental Medicine, and an additional 1.5 hour lecture from distinguished faculty from SBU's School of Dental Medicine. Clinical observations and the faculty lecture will take place the week of July 15 - 19, 2019 as outlined below.

Tuesday - Friday 2:00pm - 5:00pm
Lecture 10:00am - 11:30am (Date and time to be confirmed)

4. KU students will have the opportunity to participate in all cultural activities and events planned for the 2019 Global Summer Institute. Detailed activities are listed in the attached program schedule.
5. KU will pay the sum of USD 2,587 for each participant, for a total of 10 students. This amount includes all tuition and fees, on-campus housing in a single room, health insurance, and some cultural events and activities as outlined in the attached program

schedule.

6. KU will pay to SBU all course fees identified above by July 14, 2019.
7. Other matters:
 1. Health insurance is included in the fee and required by SBU. Overseas travel accident insurance is not adequate.
 2. Any changes to the program will be made after discussion and agreement between the two universities.
 3. KU students will arrive and depart SBU as one group.
 4. Should any student cancel his/her participation after the date this MOU is signed by KU, KU will be responsible for all fees. SBU will not issue any refunds.
