

**APPENDIX
TO THE GRADUATE DUAL DEGREE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
AJOU UNIVERSITY, KOREA
AND
THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK, U.S.A**

Ajou University (AU) and the State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) hereby incorporate this Appendix to the Dual Degree Agreement in order to facilitate the implementation of the dual degree program.

1. Department

This Appendix is restrictively applied to the following departments;

Ajou University

- Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering
- Department of Computer Engineering

The State University of New York at Stony Brook

- Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering
- Department of Computer Science

2. Nomination Requirements

Nominated students shall have the following requirements;

For AU students

- GPA 3.25/4.5 or above
- a minimal TOEFL score of 550 on PBT (213 on CBT or 79 on IBT)

For SBU students

- GPA 3.0/4.0 or above
- a minimal TOEFL score of 550 on PBT (213 on CBT or 79 on IBT)
- SBU students with American citizenship are exempted from the above TOEFL score requirement

All nominated students shall have recommendation from the dean of the graduate school or the head of the department

Nominated students must complete half of the required credits at a home university before they start their studies at a host university.

3. Registration

Admitted students shall be registered for at least two semesters at each university for a doctoral degree and three semesters for a master's and doctoral combined degree.

4. Credit Requirement

Students in the dual degree program must meet the credit requirement of the host university, and the home university shall recognize the credit requirement of the host university.

5. Research Advisor

Each university shall designate one research advisor respectively.

6. Comprehensive Examination

Students in the dual degree program shall be allowed to pass only one comprehensive examination of either university.

7. Foreign Language Examination

Students in the dual degree program shall be exempted from the foreign language examination requirement.

8. Qualification to Submit Thesis for Doctoral Degree

A student should meet the following academic publication requirement on the contents of the dissertation;

- Science and engineering fields: Two or more journal publications including at least one international article

9. Thesis Defense Committee

For a doctoral degree, the committee shall consist of five or more faculty members holding a doctoral degree, and must include both research advisors and one additional professor from each university.

10. Language of Thesis

The thesis shall be written in English.

11. Financial Support

Each university will provide financial assistance to students who are eligible for scholarship.

This Appendix shall be in effect for the same period as the Dual Degree Agreement and may be adjusted in writing upon mutual agreement of the two parties.


