

LEAKEY FELLOWS PROGRAM APPENDIX
to the
AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION
between
STONY BROOK UNIVERSITY, STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK
and
UNITED STATES INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY

Inspired by Drs. Meave and Richard Leakey and created in collaboration with the Graduate School of Stony Brook University (SBU), the Leakey Fellows Program (LFP) will provide access to graduate education at Stony Brook for students from East Africa, particularly Kenya and Tanzania. The purpose of the Leakey Fellows Program is to develop a cadre of educated individuals who will return to East Africa, in public service or as university faculty, to assume leadership in cultivating larger numbers of East Africa undergraduate students who will be then prepared to participate responsibly in shaping the future of the region.

In accordance with Section II of the Agreement of Cooperation, the following mechanisms to create the Leakey Fellows Program are established:

1. Leakey Fellows will be degree candidates at SBU.
2. The number of students to be accepted each year will be determined by mutual consent no later than February 1 of the preceding academic year.
3. Selection of students will take place at USIU, by a committee that must include a Leakey family member; all meetings of said committee shall have a representative of the Leakeys in attendance.
4. Student dossiers should be received at the host institution no later than March 15 for fall admission.
5. SBU shall assist incoming Leakey Fellows in arranging accommodation.
6. Leakey Fellows shall be required to obtain health coverage to the satisfaction of SBU.
7. Leakey Fellows must be enrolled in a course load at SBU for the duration of the program and in accordance with the student's degree program.
8. Leakey Fellows shall be free to choose courses from the full range available at SBU.
9. Leakey Fellows shall comply with all rules and regulations of the host university, including relevant academic standing and conduct requirements.
10. Neither university shall be liable for the acts of the other or for the acts of students participating in this program.

11. SBU shall assist Leakey Fellows in obtaining visas and other required documents for entry to the host country. To comply with host country regulations, Leakey Fellows shall be required to provide a guarantee that they have financial resources sufficient to meet all expenses.
12. This Appendix shall be in effect for the same period as the Agreement of Cooperation and may be adjusted in writing upon mutual agreement of the two parties. For matters not covered in Appendix, the universities shall consult their Agreement of Cooperation.
