

**Memorandum of Intent**  
**On Academic and Research Collaboration Programs**  
**Between State University of New York at Stony Brook, U.S.A.,**  
**and**  
**Ajou University, Korea**

This Memorandum of Intent establishes the principle of cooperation and exchange between the University at Stony Brook and Ajou University (hereinafter referred to as 'the parties'). Both parties having recognized the importance to each of fostering joint collaboration in education, training and research programs

agree to explore further the following undertakings:

**1. The parties undertake to encourage:**

**1) Establishment of Wireless Internet Research Center(WIRC) at Ajou University**

- Ajou University and Stony Brook University agree to work together to establish a sister relationship that has as its intent the establishment of a Center of Excellence in Wireless Internet and Other Technologies at Anju University. Said Center would be developed at Ajou University in cooperation with Korean companies in Information Technology.

**2) AJOU-SUNY Joint Degree Program for undergraduate students.**

- Ajou University and Stony Brook University agree to explore the potential for joint Degree programs including the potential for the selection of students from Anju University who wish to transfer to Stony Brook University after completion of two-year-undergraduate study at Ajou University. Students would receive bachelor's degrees from both Ajou University and SUNY at Stony Brook upon completing all requirements for the bachelor's degree at both universities.

**3) M. A. in TESOL Program**

- Ajou University and Stony Brook University agree to explore the implementation of a cooperative Masters Program in TESOL. Under this program Anju would send students who completed one year in M.A. in TESOL program at Ajou University to Stony Brook University to complete their study. Upon completion of TESOL studies at both universities, students could be awarded a master's degree in TESOL from the SUNY at Stony Brook.

**4) Cooperation in Korean Studies Program**

- Stony Brook University agrees that it shall seek to identify students in the Stony Brook University Korean Studies Program who could enhance their academic experience by attending Ajou University for one academic semester or for a six-

week international summer program in Korean studies.

**5) Cooperation in Business Administration Program**

- Ajou University and Stony Brook University agree to explore the potential for an exchange of students (both undergraduate and graduate) majoring in business administration. It is believed that students from Anju University and Stony Brook University who participate in a program of this type would enhance their academic experience by learning about the differing business and cultural practices in each others country.


**6) Cooperation in the field of Medicine**

In view of the fact that both Ajou University and Stony Brook University have a Medical School and tertiary care Hospital, it is believed that both intuitions might benefit from a program of mutual collaboration. Accordingly, Anju University and Stony Brook University will seek to explore the benefits accruing from a program of close collaboration including the exchange of faculty and students.

2. This Memorandum of Intent is recognized by the parties as the first step towards future mutual cooperation.
3. Both parties agree to review this Memorandum of Intent after three years in order to evaluate the progress of mutual cooperation and improve the quality of cooperation.
