

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION
between
THE UNIVERSITY OF AUCKLAND
AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND
and the
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
United States of America

The University of Auckland, New Zealand, hereinafter referred to as Auckland and the State University of New York at Stony Brook, hereinafter referred to as Stony Brook, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between universities contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Agreement of Cooperation.

I

This Agreement of Cooperation will promote activities in the following principal areas:

- Exchange of students.
- Exchange of academic staff and research scholars.
- Collaborative research, instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interest, exchange of bibliographic materials and shared access to information networks.

II

Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in corresponding Appendices to this Agreement.


III

All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will respect and conform to the corresponding norms, traditions and regulations and relevant statutory requirements of each University.

IV

1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective from the date of signing by both parties.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, Auckland and Stony Brook agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to this Cooperative Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses. Any such change shall become effective from the date it is approved by both universities.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be renewed automatically for an additional five years, unless Auckland or Stony Brook provides written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. In the event that this Agreement is terminated, both universities agree that any exchange or other collaborative programme already approved shall be permitted to continue as if the Agreement had remained in force.




