MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK,
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
AND
UNIVERSITY OF AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND
IN
MARINE SCIENCES

1

The State University of New York at Stony Brook, hereafter referred to as SUSB, and the University of Auckland, hereafter referred to as U of A, hereby agree to enhance scholarly interaction through the promotion of systematic, continuing exchange opportunities for faculty, students and professional staff to participate in instruction, research and service in accordance with the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Realization of the above stated agreement shall take the following forms of cooperation in the Marine Sciences:

1. Collaborative and cooperative programs of teaching, research and extension services.
2. Discussions on academic, research and administrative developments.
3. Mutual exchange of scholarly publications and research reports in fields of common interest.

The President of SUSB and Vice Chancellor of U of A will designate a program coordinator to facilitate interaction between the two Universities.

4

The number of participants in the exchange shall be determined by mutual agreement between SUSB and U of A each year. The number shall be determined by the fiscal resources available to each part of the agreement.

All participants in the exchange must be covered by medical insurance, the cost of which is to be borne by the exchangee.

Both parties agree to waive all tuition charges and to assist exchangees in gaining access to off-campus facilities which may be needed in the planned study or research.

SUSB will reserve rooms in the University dormitory for the U of A student participant. The cost of the dormitory room will be paid by the exchangee. In New Zealand, assistance will be provided to SUSB student participants by U of A for the location of appropriate housing.

Each institution will assist each exchangee in obtaining the appropriate visa for the period of the exchange visit.

The obligations of the parties under this agreement are to the participants only and are not inclusive of spouses and dependents.

The present agreement is for a period of two years starting with the date of its signature. The agreement may be extended for further periods upon the mutual agreement of both parties.

Any modification concerning the present agreement may be introduced with mutual consent. Either party reserves the right to discontinue the present agreement upon six months notice.

The present agreement shall enter into force on the date of signing.

The coordinators will present a joint annual report to the two institutions.

It is understood that the terms of this understanding are subject to the approval of the Chancellor of the State University of New York and the Office of the Chancellor of the University of Auckland.
