

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK

UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

And
GÖTTINGEN School of Oncology at the GÖTTINGEN Comprehensive Cancer Center
at GÖTTINGEN UNIVERSITY, GERMANY

State University of New York at Stony Brook, United States of America, hereinafter referred to as SBU, and GÖTTINGEN UNIVERSITY, GERMANY, hereinafter referred to as PARTNER UNIVERSITY in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to training and research, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Agreement of Cooperation.

I

This agreement will promote exchange activities in biomedical research, in particular in cancer-related research (excluding patient contact and patient medical care):

- Exchange of graduate students
- Exchange of faculty, postdoctoral fellows and other academic researchers
- Research methods instructional programs

II

1. Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices of each University, as well as the law and regulations of the partner, including applicable portions of the U.S. Export Controls Act.
2. Both Institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United States of America and Germany, and shall comply with the regulations and policies of GÖTTINGEN UNIVERSITY and SBU.

IV


1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of signing.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, GÖTTINGEN UNIVERSITY and SBU agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be automatically renewed by mutual agreement for an additional five year, unless Stony Brook or GÖTTINGEN UNIVERSITY provide written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitments to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.






