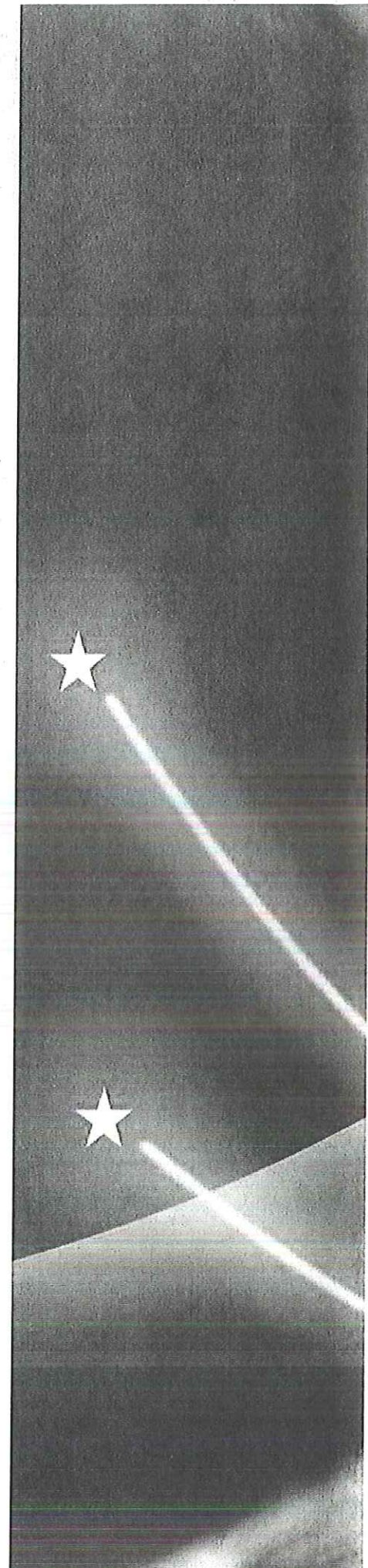

*Memorandum of Understanding*  
ON WIRELESS INTERNET RESEARCH COLLABORATION

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is by and between the GYEONGGI PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT of the Republic of Korea (hereinafter "Gyeonggi Province"), and the STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK (hereinafter "SUNY-SBU").

WHEREAS, Gyeonggi Province and SUNY-SBU have demonstrated a strong and enduring commitment to advancing developments in the sciences and technology;

WHEREAS, the Gyeonggi Small & Medium Business Center has established a Wireless Internet Research Institute (here in after "WIRI") and actively promotes the efforts of industries engaged in emerging technologies, including next generation wireless Internet research;

WHEREAS, SUNY-SBU is planning to create a Center of Excellence in Wireless and Information Technology to provide research, education, workforce training and economic development for individuals and industries that specialize in disciplines utilizing information technology;

WHEREAS, SUNY-SBU and Gyeonggi Province wish to promote mutual exchange, cooperation and assistance in the area of next-generation wireless Internet research;


NOW THEREFORE, based on the spirit of equal and mutual benefit, SUNY-SBU and Gyeonggi Province agree as follows:


1. SUNY-SBU and the Gyeonggi Small & Medium Business Center will cooperate to the extent permitted by the relevant laws of their respective nations, including relevant immigration requirements and SUNY Policies, to promote an extensive exchange of research technology, information resources and scientific personnel.
2. The Dean of SUNY-SBU's College of Engineering & Applied Sciences and the President of "WIRI" of the Gyeonggi Small & Medium Business Center will be responsible for administering and implementing this agreement on behalf of SUNY-SBU and Gyeonggi Province.
3. This agreement will take effect from the date of signature and shall continue for five years, at the end of which it may be renewed by mutual agreement.

To enhance their cooperative effort, the parties agree that this Memorandum shall serve as a basis for future discussion and activity, and further agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to this Memorandum by mutual written agreement.

This Memorandum shall be executed in English, in duplicate, and signed at the Stony Brook University in the State of New York. SUNY-SBU and the Gyeonggi Province each shall maintain an official copy.
