



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
and
INTERDISCIPLINARY CENTER HERZLIYA
ISRAEL

The State University of New York at Stony Brook, the United States of America (hereafter "SBU"), and Interdisciplinary Center Herzliya, Israel (hereafter "IDC"), in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutions of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Memorandum of Understanding ("Agreement").

I. Scope of Agreement

1. This Agreement will promote activities in the following areas:
 - Exchange of students
 - Exchange of faculty and academic staff
 - Instructional and cultural programs
 - Collaboration of academic degree programs
 - Collaborative research

2. Prior to implementation of any particular cooperative and collaborative activities, parties shall enter into writing signed by the responsible authority of each institution which sets forth the terms and conditions of the activity.

II. General Provisions

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices, of each institution as well as all applicable laws and regulations of both countries.
2. Both institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of Israel and the United States of America.

III. Duration, Amendments & Termination

1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of signing of the last signatory.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, SBU and IDC agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be automatically renewed by mutual agreement for an additional five years, unless SBU or IDC provide written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months' notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitments to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.


