



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
between
INDIAN INSTITUTE OF PETROLEUM AND ENERGY
INDIA
and
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

Indian Institute of Petroleum and Energy, Andhra Pradesh, India, hereinafter referred to as IIPE, and the State University of New York at Stony Brook, New York, United States of America, hereinafter referred to as SBU, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Memorandum of Understanding.

I. Objectives

1. This Memorandum will promote activities in the following areas:
 - Exchange of students
 - Exchange of faculty and staff
 - Instructional and cultural programs
 - Collaboration of academic degree programs
 - Collaborative research
2. Prior to implementation of any of the above referenced cooperative and collaborative activities, parties shall enter into writing signed by the responsible authority of each Institution which sets forth the terms and conditions of the activity.

II. General Requirements

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Memorandum will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices of each Institution as well as all applicable laws and regulations of both countries.

2. Both Institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one Institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of both countries, and shall comply with the regulations and policies of IPE and SBU.

III. Term and Termination


1. This Memorandum is established for a period of five years, effective as of the date last signed.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, IPE and SBU agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Memorandum by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Memorandum may be renewed by mutual agreement via a written amendment signed by both parties.
4. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Memorandum. In the event of termination, all commitments to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.
