

**Memorandum of Understanding**  
**between**  
**The Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST)**  
**and**  
**The State Univ. of New York at Stony Brook (SUNY-SB)**  
**of the United States of America**

The Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology and the State of University of New York at Stony Brook of the United States of America agree to explore reciprocal exchanges and cooperation, to include the following:

1. Exchange of library materials such as books, academic journals and other publications, as availability and resources permit;
2. Exchange of scientific research materials;
3. Exchange of information on professional experiences and in fields of interest to both parties;
4. Cooperative research projects to be carried out in selected fields mutually agreed upon;
5. Exchange of faculty members, research personnel, and students for lectures, visits, and joint experiments;
6. Exchange of scientists for participating in conferences, symposia, seminars, and teaching at undergraduate and graduate levels

Both parties agree that details of conditions and understandings for implementing each and any of the above, including financial arrangements necessary to implement this MOU, shall be made specific in separate and individual Agreements to be signed by appropriate authorities of both institutions and will depend upon the availability of funds. Such ensuing Agreements will identify the coordinators responsible for implementation of joint projects. It is mutually understood that securing funds to implement any of the above must be the joint responsibility of both institutions.


This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of both institutions and approval by appropriate authorities in the respective countries.


This Memorandum of Understanding is valid for a period of five years from the date of signing and may be renewed by agreement between the parties.

Both institutions subscribe to the policy of Equal Opportunity and will not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, ethnicity, religion, or national origin. KAIST and SUNY-SB shall abide by these principles in the administration of this Agreement and neither institution shall impose criteria for the exchange of scholars or students which would violate the principles of non-discrimination.
