AGREEMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION
BETWEEN
THE PRESIDENTS
OF
THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
AND
NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY

In order to create closer academic ties and to develop cooperation between the academic units related to Applied Mechanics of both universities, the Presidents of both universities have agreed to the following:


1. This agreement will serve as a general framework of cooperation between the two universities.
2. The cooperation will be focused on the area of Applied Mechanics. Later it can be extended to other fields after mutual consultation and agreement.
3. Exchange of faculty will be encouraged. Specifics of the exchanges, including the number of faculty, duration of stay, obligations of parties concerned, and other matters, will be discussed and agreed upon through correspondence.
4. Exchange of graduate students will be encouraged.
5. Exchange of academic publications by, and photocopies of important library materials of the two universities will be facilitated.
6. Cooperative research programs may be carried out on the initiative of either party.

Both institutions understand that such mutual assistance and financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular activity or program.

The agreement will be valid from its signing by the Presidents of both universities. Any amendment will require the written consent of both Presidents and will be attached to this document. Either party reserves the right to terminate this agreement upon one year written notice to the other.
