

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

**STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK (SBU)
STONY BROOK, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**

AND

**NANJING UNIVERSITY OF INFORMATION SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY (NUIST)
NANJING, CHINA**

ARTICLE I: PREAMBLE

1. Recognizing the mutual benefits to be gained through cooperative education, academic cooperation and international understanding, the State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) and Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology (NUIST) hereby enter into this Memorandum of Understanding and agree to the following:

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

2. The purpose of this Memorandum is to facilitate and promote cooperation between the State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) and Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology (NUIST), with a view to support cooperative education, research collaboration, capacity building and other forms of academic partnership.

ARTICLE III: AREAS OF COLLABORATION

3. Specific areas of collaboration will be identified in the course of consultations between the State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) and Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology (NUIST).

ARTICLE IV: IMPLEMENTATION

- 4.1 Individual programs will be jointly planned and conducted by both parties.
- 4.2 Progress of each individual program will be reviewed and approved by both parties.
- 4.3 Final approval of any project will be dependent upon the availability of funding.
- 4.4 Specific details of any project will be set forth in agreements supplemental to the Memorandum, the terms of which will be subject to the mutual approval of both parties.


4.5 The State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) and Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology (NUIST) acknowledge and agree that, for the purpose of fulfilling their respective obligations pursuant to this Memorandum, they will share personal information of their respective faculty and students taking part in the exchanges contemplated by this Memorandum. The State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) and Nanjing University of Information Science and Technology (NUIST) mutually covenant and agree that they will treat any such personal information in strict compliance with their local law in that respect, in all ways as if it were the personal information of their own faculty and students. Any improper use of faculty or student personal information may subject the user to legal liability.

ARTICLE V: TERM OF THE MEMORANDUM

- 5.1 This Memorandum shall commence on the date of signing and shall continue for a period of two (2) years.
- 5.2 This Memorandum may be terminated by either party with three month notice.
- 5.3 This Memorandum may be extended by mutual consent of both parties.
- 5.4 This Memorandum will be amended as required to reflect the expansion of the collaboration activities. Any amendment to the Memorandum may be made by the exchange of letters between the two parties.
