

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION
between
SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
The School of International and Area Studies
and the
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
United States of America

The School of International and Area Studies at Seoul National University, hereinafter referred to as SIAS-Seoul University and the State University of New York at Stony Brook, hereinafter referred to as Stony Brook, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between universities contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Agreement of Cooperation.

I

This Agreement of Cooperation will promote activities in the following principal areas:

- Exchange of students.
- Exchange of faculty and academic staff.
- Collaborative research, instructional and cultural programs, including publication activities of mutual interest, exchange of bibliographic materials and shared access to information networks.

II

Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in corresponding Appendices to this Agreement.

III

All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will respect and conform to the corresponding norms, traditions and regulations of each University.

IV


1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of signing.

2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, SIAS-Seoul University and Stony Brook agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to this Cooperative Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be renewed automatically for an additional five years, unless SIAS-Seoul University or Stony Brook provides written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date.
