

Agreement on Korean Studies Series Publication
between
The State University of New York at Stony Brook
Stony Brook, New York, USA
and
Seoul National University
Seoul, Republic of Korea

In recognition of the common interests shared by the State University of New York at Stony Brook (USB) and Seoul National University (SNU), as articulated in the Agreement of Cooperation of July 20, 1991, the two universities are pleased to establish this Agreement on Korean Studies Series Publication, which is designed to provide mechanisms for their cooperation in the publication project.

1. The Institute of Korean Studies on behalf of SNU and the Center for Korean Studies on behalf of USB shall be the co-agents of this project.
2. In terms of concrete duties, SNU shall handle preparation of the manuscript, and USB shall handle translating, editing and publishing. However, both universities shall share general responsibility for the project as a whole.
3. The authors shall have the right to examine English versions of their drafts before printing.
4. Regulations made by the Editorial Board of SUNY Press shall be honored in the process of publication.
5. Each university shall fund the part of the project for which it is responsible. Both universities shall collaborate to secure funds for translation.


6. A separate agreement shall be made by each of the two universities regarding distribution of royalties and profits.
7. Publication for the first term of the project, from 1992 to 1996, shall include books in eleven areas: Korean language, literature, history, Buddhism, Confucianism, politics, economy, art, society, education and science.
8. The books published in the Series shall be scholarly works which will deserve the attention of specialists, but which may also serve as texts for Korean studies courses in English speaking universities.
9. The preparation of each of the eleven fields shall begin simultaneously. However, a book may be published at the time its manuscript is completed.
10. For the second term of the project, the publication of books in areas other than the above mentioned eleven and translations of classical Korean works may be considered.
11. The title of the series shall be "Korean Studies Series", and the names of its agents shall be specified as "SNU/USB".
12. This Agreement will commence on the date of endorsement by the presidents of the two universities.
