

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
between  
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK  
STONY BROOK,  
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA  
and  
TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF FOREIGN STUDIES  
TOKYO, JAPAN

The State University of New York at Stony Brook, United States of America, hereinafter referred to as SBU, and Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, Tokyo, hereinafter referred to as TUFS, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutions of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Memorandum of Understanding.

I

1. This MOU will promote activities in the following areas:

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty and academic staff
- Instructional and cultural programs
- Exchange of academic information and publication
- Other activities mutually agreed upon between both institutions

II

1. Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this MOU will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices, of each institution as well as the law and regulations of the host, including applicable portions of the U.S. Export Controls Act and Export Trade Control Order of Japan.

2. Both institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United States of America and Japan, shall comply with the regulations and policies of SBU and TUFSS.

#### IV

1. Detailed management of intellectual property rights and publication shall be consistent with policies of SBU and TUFSS and defined for each activity agreed in Article I.

#### V

1. The institutions agree that they will use their best efforts to resolve any differing viewpoints and interpretations of this MOU, by mutual consultation or negotiation.


#### VI

1. This MOU is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of signing.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, SBU and TUFSS agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the MOU by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this MOU will be renewed by mutual agreement for an additional five year prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months' notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the MOU. In the event of termination, all commitments to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.

This MOU is made in English as the mutually agreed official language. Two copies of this MOU are made and signed in original by both institutions.


