

**AGREEMENT ON GENERAL COOPERATION**  
**between**  
**STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK**  
**STONY BROOK, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**  
**and**  
**THE UNIVERSITY OF MACAU**  
**MACAO SAR, THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

The State University of New York at Stony Brook, the United States of America, hereinafter referred to as SBU, and the University of Macau, Macao SAR, the People's Republic of China, hereinafter referred to as UM, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following agreement on education and academic cooperation (Agreement).

I

This Agreement will promote activities in the following areas:

- Instructional and cultural programs
- Collaboration of academic programs
- Collaborative research

II

1. Prior to implementation of any of the above referenced cooperative and collaborative activities, parties shall enter into writing signed by the responsible authority of each institution which sets forth the terms and conditions of the activity.


III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices, of each University as well as all applicable laws and regulations of both countries.
2. Both Institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United States of America and the People's Republic of China, and shall comply with the regulations and policies of SBU and UM.

## IV

1. This Agreement is established for a period of three years, effective on the date of signing.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, SBU and UM agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of the three-year period, this Agreement will be automatically renewed by mutual agreement for an additional three years, unless SBU or UM provide written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement. In the event of termination, all commitments to students participating in the program will be honored by relevant parties.
