**SCIENTIFIC AND EDUCATIONAL COOPERATION
between
COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
and
FACULTY OF LETTERS AND PHILOSOPHY
SAPIENZA UNIVERSITY OF ROME**

In accordance with Section II of the Memorandum of Understanding between the State University of New York at Stony Brook, hereinafter SBU, and the Sapienza University of Rome, hereinafter Sapeinza, the following mechanisms designed to encourage and facilitate scientific and educational cooperation are hereby established:

1. Scientific and educational cooperation shall be undertaken in the following fields:
 - a) Comparative Literature
 - b) Cultural Studies
 - c) Film Studies
 - d) Italian Studies
 - e) Italian language and literature
 - f) History
 - g) Global and Transnational Studies
 - h) Migration Studies
 - i) Anthropology
 - j) African and Asian Studies

Such cooperation shall be carried out on the basis of equal and mutual benefits, reserving the opportunity to define, through mutual consent, further fields of activity.

2. The aforementioned scientific and educational cooperation may be implemented in the following ways:
 - a) exchange of visits by scholars;
 - b) participation in research programs;
 - c) organization of scientific meetings, seminars and courses,
 - d) exchange of scientific information and scientific papers.

3. If both parties agree to undertake specific joint projects with legally binding obligations, they will develop separate written agreements for such projects, setting out each party's contributions, deliverables, and budgets.
4. The scholars in the faculty exchange shall be responsible for all costs and expenses incurred by the Participant, including, but not limited to, wages, fringe benefits, medical expenses, travel and living expenses unless otherwise agreed.
5. Prior to planned activities, the respective scientific scholars involved in the project in both parties shall make a contact, exchanging all the necessary information including procedures and timeline required for the effective execution of the activity.
6. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices, of each institution as well as all applicable laws and regulations. This Agreement shall be subject to all applicable government export and import laws and regulations. The parties agree to comply and reasonably assist the other party, upon request by that party, in complying with all applicable government export and import laws and regulations.
7. The respective scientific scholars shall be required to enroll in the mandatory health insurance program of the host university and shall be responsible for all deductible costs related to health care services.
8. The host university shall assist the scholar to obtain visas and other documents required for entry to the host country. To comply with host country regulations, the scholar shall be required to provide a guarantee that they have financial resources sufficient to meet all expenses.
9. The Agreement is in effect for one year from the date of signing and may be subject to change, renewal, and termination by mutual consent. Any alteration or amendment to this Agreement must be made in writing and agreed by both parties. The parties may terminate the Agreement by providing at least six months written notice of termination to the other party.
10. Dr. Franca Sinopoli for Sapienza and Dr. Robert Harvey for SBU are responsible for the project of the respective scientific scholars.
