

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK  
STONY BROOK,  
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

And

ZHONGNAN UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS AND LAW  
WU HAN  
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

Zhongnan University of Economics and Law, People's Republic of China, hereinafter referred to as ZUEL, and State University of New York at Stony Brook, United States of America, hereinafter referred to as SBU, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations and convinced that cooperation between institutes of higher learning contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between countries, agree to establish the following Agreement of Cooperation.

I

This agreement will promote activities in the following areas:\*

- Exchange of students
- Exchange of faculty and academic staff\*
- Instructional and cultural programs
- The development of a Confucius Institute at SBU, in cooperation with ZUEL

II

1. Specific mechanisms for the implementation of particular cooperative and collaborative activities shall be established and described in writing by the responsible authority of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.

III

1. All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will comply with the procedures, policies, and practices, of each University as well as the law and regulations of the host, including applicable portions of the U.S. Export Controls Act.
2. Both Institutions acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one institution to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United States of America and People's Republic of China, shall comply with the regulations and policies of ZUEL and SBU.

IV


1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective on the date of signing.
2. In order to enhance the efficacy of their cooperative activities, ZUEL and SBU agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to the Agreement by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, this Agreement will be automatically renewed by mutual agreement for an additional five year, unless either party provides written notification of a decision of non-renewal prior to the expiration date. A minimum period of six months notice will be required from either party wishing to terminate the Agreement.
