Tel Aviv International Summer School

Tel Aviv Summer University and Stony Brook University agree upon the following terms and conditions.

1. The purpose of the memorandum is to strengthen mutual understanding and increase international cooperation between Stony Brook University and Tel Aviv International Summer University.
2. Tel Aviv University agrees to admit students nominated by Stony Brook University to its respective summer terms on the basis of Stony Brook University's institutional recommendation. Stony Brook University will provide Tel Aviv University with a list of selected students 4 weeks prior to the start of the Tel Aviv University term. Places will be assigned on the first-come, first-served basis. The Tel Aviv University General Terms and Conditions and Academic Policies published on the Tel Aviv University website and communicated to all program applicants apply.
3. Tel Aviv University will organize the accommodation for the students from Stony Brook University in dormitories.
4. Tel Aviv University will issue a group invoice which will be sent directly to Stony Brook University. The invoice will include program tuition fees and housing. Students will be billed directly for optional expenses not included in the program (such as excursions, meal plan, etc.).
5. Tel Aviv University will provide student orientation, course material and an official transcript for each student which will be sent to Stony Brook University. Students will have access to Tel Aviv University facilities such as library, computer services, cafeteria etc.
6. Tel Aviv University will make reasonable effort to provide a safe and secure learning and living environment for the students during the program period.
7. This agreement is valid for an indefinite period but may be terminated by either Tel Aviv University or Stony Brook University by written notice at least 6 months before the next Tel Aviv Summer University term.
