Clinical Facility Agreement
State University of New York

WHEREAS, Chungnam National University has a curriculum in medical studies and desires that its medical students obtain certain clinical experience at Stony Brook University Medical Center (Hospital), and

WHEREAS, clinical fieldwork experience is a required and integral component for such curriculum, and

WHEREAS, Chungnam National University desires that its medical students be given access to the Hospital in the development and implementation of the clinical fieldwork experience phase of its curriculum, and

WHEREAS, the Hospital and Chungnam National University recognize that the Hospital has the facilities necessary for Chungnam National University College of Medicine's medical students to participate in medical education

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually understood and agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. Chungnam National University may send to the Hospital certain medical students in designated numbers as determined by the Hospital and at such times as shall be agreed upon in advance by the parties. Chungnam National University will notify the Stony Brook University School of Medicine (Stony Brook SOM) and/ or the Hospital of the name of each student and the time to be spent by the student at the Hospital prior to the start of the clinical fieldwork experience of students, as set out in the Chungnam National University course descriptions and objectives which will be sent to Stony Brook in January of each year or more often, if needed. Stony Brook SOM will reciprocally notify Chungnam National University of the courses – descriptions and objectives – available for the Chungnam exchange students.
2. The ultimate responsibility for all training and clinical fieldwork experience to satisfy the educational requirements shall rest exclusively with the Chungnam National University faculty. All clinical experiences must be in compliance with the policies and procedures of the Hospital, Stony Brook SOM, New York State Department of Education, New York State Department of Health and all applicable laws and regulations.
3. The Hospital shall make available appropriate fieldwork experience, consistent with patient's rights, enabling students to meet objectives of the educational program, consistent with the course description and objectives outlined in Exhibit B.
4. If requested in advance in writing by Chungnam National University, the Hospital will evaluate the performance of the assigned student on a basis established in advance of experience, using the form(s) supplied by Chungnam National University. All evaluations, if any, by students of the Hospital staff and experience at the Hospital shall be made available to the appropriate Hospital department head. Chungnam National University will maintain and retain all records and reports of each student's clinical fieldwork experience and shall make these records available to the Hospital upon request.
5. Chungnam National University COM and the Hospital in consultation with Stony Brook SOM shall maintain ongoing communication to coordinate the scheduling of academic and

clinical fieldwork experience. Chungnam National University will designate an educational coordinator and the Hospital will designate a clinical fieldwork supervisor who shall supervise the student(s) while at "Hospital".

6. The Hospital will make available facilities such as, library and cafeteria facilities for faculty and students of Chungnam National University at the sole cost of the student (s) or Chungnam National University.
7. In case of emergency illness or injury during the clinical fieldwork experience, the Hospital will provide emergency care to students at the student's own expense. In the event that care or treatment is required beyond the emergency, the student shall be responsible for arranging such care or treatment and for all associated costs.
8. The students of Chungnam National University shall not be deemed employees of the Hospital, Stony Brook SOM, State University of New York (SUNY) or the State of New York. The Hospital, Stony Brook SOM or SUNY shall pay no stipend or other consideration to students, nor shall Chungnam National University or its students pay any consideration to the Hospital, in exchange for the clinical fieldwork experience.
9. Chungnam National University shall require students to conduct themselves in accordance with the Hospital's rules and regulations. Upon request, the Hospital shall make such rules and regulations available to Chungnam National University, their faculty and students for review as necessary. The Hospital reserves the right to dismiss from the Hospital at any time any student or faculty from Chungnam National University whose condition or conduct jeopardizes the well-being of its patients or employees, volunteers or other students or interferes with the usual operations of the Hospital. Unless unusual circumstances exist, reasonable efforts will be made by Hospital to consult with Chungnam National University's designated contact person prior to such dismissal. At the request of the Hospital or Stony Brook SOM, Chungnam National University shall immediately and permanently suspend from the Hospital and/or Stony Brook SOM and suspend from continuing in the clinical experience, any student or Chungnam National University faculty member who fails to obey such rules and regulations of the Hospital.
10. Chungnam National University shall require all students to maintain information concerning patients as confidential and not to be released to any person without prior written approval from the Hospital, consistent with all applicable state, and federal laws and any applicable policies and procedures of the Hospital.
11. If either party wishes to terminate this Clinical Facility Agreement, it is understood that written notice will be given to the other party at least thirty (30) days in advance of such termination. Reasonable efforts will be made to provide that students then enrolled in clinical fieldwork experience at the Hospital will have the opportunity to complete the experience at the Hospital. This Attachment shall terminate automatically upon the termination of the Agreement of Cooperation, or upon termination of Student Exchange Appendix to Agreement of Cooperation.
12. The Hospital and Chungnam National University will not discriminate against any employee, applicant or student enrolled in their respective programs because of age, handicap, color, national origin, race, religion or sex.
13. Chungnam National University shall ensure that all students are in good health prior to beginning or continuing clinical fieldwork experience at the Hospital. Chungnam National University and / or the student must submit to Hospital documented evidence of a physical examination performed within the twelve (12) months preceding the start of the clinical fieldwork experience at the Hospital. This documentation must certify that the student is in

good health and does not pose a health risk to the patients or employees at the Hospital. Chungnam National University and / or the student must also submit documented evidence that the student is immune to rubella (German measles) and rubeola (measles), that the student has been immunized against tetanus and diphtheria within the past 10 years, and that the student is free from active tuberculosis, and any other health requirements established by law, regulations, including, but not limited to Department of Health regulations and/ or Hospital policy. Documented evidence of the student's varicella titer must also be submitted. All such documented evidence must be submitted to the Hospital for review prior to the start of any clinical fieldwork experience. Chungnam National University agrees that no student will be sent to Hospital without prior delivery of documented evidence of the above.

14. Chungnam National University shall attest that the students it sends to Stony Brook SOM have no criminal record and are of high integrity and professionalism.
15. Chungnam National University agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless State University of New York, State University of New York at Stony Brook, Stony Brook University Medical Center, and the State of New York, and its officers and employees for all acts or omissions of Chungnam National, its officers employees and agents and /or its students of Chungnam National University engaged in the educational exchange program at Stony Brook University School of Medicine and Stony Brook University Medical Center. In order to meet the above obligations Chungnam National University shall either procure sufficient insurance to cover its obligations above or set aside a sufficient fund intended for and dedicated to cover such potential obligations noted above. Additionally, Chungnam National University on behalf of itself and on behalf of its students acknowledges that the State University of New York, State University of New York at Stony Brook, Stony Brook Medical Center, the State of New York does NOT procure any insurance coverage for the Chungnam National University students, nor does State University of New York, Stony Brook University Medical Center nor State of New York consider the Chungnam National University students, officers employees or agents of the State University of New York, State University of New York at Stony Brook, Stony Brook University Medical Center or the State of New York. At all times the Chungnam National University students remain solely agents of Chungnam National University who assumes full responsibility for all acts and or omissions of its students. This provision survives termination of the agreement.

SUNY on behalf of Stony Brook University Medical Center to the fullest extent authorized by New York law shall be responsible for any and all liability, loss, claim, damage, suit, judgment and any and all costs and expenses including attorneys fees, if assessed by a court of competent jurisdiction, arising from the activities of the State University, provided that such liability, claims, losses, damages, suits or judgments arise out of the acts or omissions of the State University or its officers, or employees acting within the scope of their employment, as provided by law. This provision does not apply to any liability, claim, suit, damage, or judgment on behalf of any other party other than the State University, or its officers, or employees.

16. This agreement shall be governed by the state laws of New York.
17. The Hospital retains the ultimate responsibility for the quality and safety of patient care.
18. The parties hereto recognize that in the performance of this contract the greatest benefits will be derived by promoting the interests of both parties and each of the parties does, therefore, enter into this contract with the intention of loyally cooperating with the other in carrying out the terms of this contract and each party agrees to interpret its provisions insofar as it may legally do so, in such a manner as will best promote the interests of both and render the highest service to the public.

19. The students and faculty shall respect the confidential nature of all information that they have access to, including but not limited to patients personal health information provided to them orally, contained in patient medical records or maintained on the Hospital's electronic information system.

Chungnam National University shall require all students to comply with all relevant state and federal confidentiality laws, including the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), to the extent applicable. The Hospital and Stony Brook SOM will provide students with training in the requirements of the privacy and security provisions of HIPAA. Chungnam National University students are required to comply with the Hospital's policies and procedures relative to HIPAA. Hospital agrees to provide students and faculty, on request, with copies of or access to Hospital's policies and procedures relative to HIPAA. Chungnam National University shall ensure that students shall not remove any Protected Health Information (PHI) or data from Hospital.

20. Any amendments to this agreement must be in writing and on mutual consent.
21. All notices to parties hereunder must be in writing, signed by the party giving it, and shall be served either personally or by certified mail, return receipt requested, and addressed as follows:






