

Addendum to the Student Exchange Agreement
between
The State University of New York at Stony Brook
and
City University of Hong Kong

To encourage academic collaboration and to facilitate as much as possible the academic progress and cultural orientation of all exchange students, The State University of New York at Stony Brook (SBU) and City University of Hong Kong (CityU) signed a student exchange agreement as open end in 2006. In view of the flourishing exchange, both institutions agree to revise the annual exchange quota as follows:

- (i) There shall be additional eight (8) semester-long exchange places reserved to the undergraduate students in SBU and CityU where four (4) out of eight (8) places are specifically for the College of Humanities and Social Science. The application procedures, requirements and exchange conditions for these exchange students shall follow the terms and conditions laid down in the 2006 Agreement.
- (ii) The annual exchange quota shall be revised to be a total of twelve (12) semester-long places.

This Addendum will be effective from the last date signed by the signatories below and its expiry and termination conditions follows the 2006 Agreement.
