Summer & Fall 2012 Program to be held at Stony Brook University  
State University of New York

In accordance with the Student Exchange Appendix, this annex designed to facilitate international cooperation and student exchange between College of Engineering and Applied Science of Stony Brook University (hereinafter known as "SBU/CEAS") and Creative IT Excellence Engineering of Pohang University of Science and Technology (hereinafter known as "POSTECH/CITE") confirms the following:

- A. Stony Brook University will administer a special academic program for 20 POSTECH/CITE students during the 2012 summer session and fall semester as agreed below.
1. English Instruction: POSTECH/CITE students will enroll in the Intensive English Center (IEC) Summer program from July 9- August 16, 2012. Please see Attachment A for Class Schedule. IEC will offer social or catered events including welcome and graduation receptions. Optional field trips and extracurricular activities at additional cost will also be planned for students who wish to participate.

SUMMER SESSION COSTS:

POSTECH/CITE will pay the sum of US\$3,630\* for each course participant:

**IEC Program fee:** \$1,800 (includes tuition, catered events and graduation, and airport pick-up and drop-off)

**Housing fee:** \$1,500\* (On-campus housing in double room with kitchen facilities)

**Health Insurance:** \$185\*

**University fees:** \$150\*

\* subject to a 10% increase on costs other than IEC program fee

POSTECH/CITE will pay all summer fees to SBU by July 2, 2012.

2. After the successful completion of the Advanced IEC level with a grade of B or better, POSTECH/CITE students may register as full-time students in the Fall 2012 semester. In case POSTECH/CITE students are placed at a lower level during the summer IEC program, they will be required to attend IEC for the Fall 2012 semester with a reduced course load.

FALL SEMESTER COSTS:

POSTECH/CITE students will be responsible for paying out-of-state tuition, university fees, health insurance, and housing costs for the fall semester as follows:

**Tuition:** \$7,360\*

**Housing fee:** \$3,553\* (On-campus housing in double room with kitchen facilities)

**Health Insurance:** \$668.45\*

**University fees:** \$911.5\*


\* all prices are subject to increase as final costs are not currently set

For every 20 POSTECH/CITE students participating in the program, Stony Brook University will waive tuition for 2 out of the above 20 POSTECH/CITE students for Fall 2012.

- B. With the consent of POSTECH/CITE, SBU/CEAS may nominate students to participate in a summer program at POSTECH/CITE with internship. If POSTECH/CITE provides the program at no cost to SBU/CEAS students, then in return, SBU will accept one (1) FTE student from POSTECH/CITE per every two (2) SBU/CEAS students who register at 0.5 FTE each in the POSTECH/CITE summer program with internship, under the term of reciprocity for the student exchange within the duration of the Agreement of Cooperation.
- C. The Office of International Academic Programs and Services (IAPS) will provide support for appropriate visa and immigration processing, as well as support services for students in academic matters and extracurricular activities.
- D. The terms of this Annex shall be in effect for the duration of the SBU Summer and Fall 2012 Program and may be jointly reviewed by both POSTECH and SBU to be renewed through written agreement upon its termination.
- E. Either SBU/CEAS or POSTECH/CITE may terminate this Agreement at any time by mutual consent or by giving a sixty days' written notice.





**Summer & Fall 2013 Program to be held at Stony Brook University**  
**State University of New York**

In accordance with the Student Exchange Appendix, this annex designed to facilitate international cooperation and student exchange between International Academic Programs & Services of Stony Brook University (hereinafter known as "SBU/IAPS") and Creative IT Engineering of Pohang University of Science and Technology (hereinafter known as "POSTECH/CITE") confirms the following:

A. Stony Brook University will administer a special academic program for POSTECH/CITE students during the 2013 summer session and 2013 fall semester as agreed below.

1. English Instruction: POSTECH/CITE students will enroll in the Intensive English Center (IEC) summer program from July 8- August 16, 2013. IEC will offer social or catered events including welcome and graduation receptions. Optional field trips and extracurricular activities at additional cost will also be planned for students who wish to participate.

**SUMMER SESSION COSTS:**

IEC Program Fee: \$2,050

University fees including Health insurance: \$617.40\* (see attached)

Housing charges: \$1,800\* for double room, \$2,070\* for single room. Room rates are based on availability. Double rooms not guaranteed.

2. After the successful completion of the Advanced IEC level with a grade of B or better, POSTECH/CITE students may register as full-time visiting non-matriculated students in the Fall 2013 semester.

**FALL SEMESTER COSTS:**

POSTECH/CITE students will be responsible for paying out-of-state tuition, university fees, health insurance, and housing costs for the fall semester as follows:

**Tuition:** \$8,904.50\*

**Housing fee:** \$3,730\* for double room, \$4,339\* for single room. (Does not include intersession housing)

**University fees including Health Insurance:** \$1,571.75\* (see attached)

\* All prices are subject to increase as final costs are not currently set.


- B. International Academic Programs and Services (IAPS) will provide support for appropriate visa and immigration processing, as well as support services for students in academic matters and extracurricular activities.

In accordance with the Student Exchange Appendix, this annex designed to facilitate international cooperation and student exchange between Stony Brook University (hereinafter known as "SBU") and Creative IT Engineering of Pohang University of Science and Technology (hereinafter known as "POSTECH/CiTE") confirms the following:

A. Stony Brook University will accept POSTECH/CiTE students during the 2015 summer session and 2015 fall semester as agreed below.

1. POSTECH/CiTE students will enroll in the Summer Session II of SBU's International Summer School (ISS) for a minimum of six credits from July 6-August 14, 2015.

**SUMMER SESSION COSTS:**

**Application fee:** \$60

**Undergraduate tuition fee:** \$5,386\* (6 credits)

**University fees including Health insurance:** \$1,109.38\*

**Housing fees (42 days):** \$1,953\* for double room, \$2,275\* for single room. Room rates are based on availability. Double rooms not guaranteed.

\* All prices are subject to increase as final costs are not currently set.

2. POSTECH/CiTE students will enroll in the Fall 2015 of Academic Year/Semester program for a minimum of 12 credits.

**FALL SEMESTER COSTS:**

POSTECH/CiTE students will be responsible for paying out-of-state tuition, university fees, health insurance, and housing costs for the fall semester as follows:

**Tuition:** \$10,775\*

**Housing fee:** \$4,223\* for double room, \$4,910.85\* for single room. (Does not include intersession housing)




- B. Stony Brook University will provide support for appropriate visa and immigration processing, as well as support services for students in academic matters and extracurricular activities.

1. POSTECH/CiTE students will enroll in the Summer Session II of SBU's Global Summer Institute (GSI) for a minimum of six credits from July 10-August 19, 2017.

**SUMMER SESSION COSTS:**

**Application fee:** \$0

**Undergraduate tuition fee:** \$5,928\* (6 credits)

**University fees including Health insurance:** \$504.00\* additional insurance coverage may change amount

**Housing fees (42 days):** \$0\* for double room, Room rates are based on availability.

Double rooms not guaranteed.

Global Summer Institute students emailed in 6 credits will receive a full housing scholarship.

\* All prices are subject to increase as final costs are not currently set.

2. POSTECH/CiTE students will enroll in the Fall 2017 of Academic Year/Semester program for a minimum of 12 credits.

**FALL SEMESTER COSTS:**

POSTECH/CiTE students will be responsible for paying out-of-state tuition, university fees, health insurance, and housing costs for the fall semester as follows:

**Tuition:** \$11,855\*

**Housing fee:** \$4,308\* for double room, \$5,010\* for single room. (Does not include intersession housing)

**University fees including Health Insurance:** \$1,907.25\*

\* All prices are subject to increase as final costs are not currently set.


B. Stony Brook University will provide support for appropriate visa and immigration processing, as well as support services for students in academic matters and extracurricular activities.
