STUDENT EXCHANGE APPENDIX


In accordance with Section II of the Cooperation Agreement, the following mechanisms designed to encourage and facilitate exchange of students are hereby established;


1. The number of students — up to three students for up to 12 months each — to be exchanged each year will be determined by mutual consent no later than April 15 of the preceding year. The universities agree to achieve full reciprocity, that is, to exchange an equal number of students by the end of this Agreement.
2. The host university will make every effort to accept the students proposed by the sending university. The two universities will seek the best possible match between students' academic objectives and the host campuses' programs and courses.
3. Students will be selected no later than May 30 for fall semester arrivals and November 30 for spring semester arrivals.
4. Students who participate in the exchange program will not be degree candidates at the host university.
5. The host university will waive tuition charges for visiting students and will inform them in a timely fashion concerning fees and expenses for which the student will be responsible.
6. Each university will, to the extent possible, assist students in securing housing accommodations and in terms of achieving their study and research goals.

7. Each university will assess academic work completed at the partner university and will award credit in accordance with its academic policies and regulations.
8. This Appendix shall be in effect for the same period as the Cooperation Agreement. For matters not covered in the Appendix, the universities shall consult the Cooperation Agreement.
