

AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN EDUCATIONAL EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
AND
EWHA WOMANS UNIVERSITY

WHEREAS the parties believe that the educational process at their respective institutions would be enhanced and mutual understanding between their respective students would be increased by the establishment of a student exchange program.


NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Commencing with the 1992 academic year, and in each succeeding year during the term of this agreement, not more than two students enrolled at SUNY-SB may be enrolled at Ewha and not more than two students enrolled at Ewha may enroll at SUNY-SB. Students may enroll for less than one academic year if appropriate to their selected course of study. Students shall have completed at least two years of university work prior to enrollment. Participating students will continue as candidates for degrees of their home institution, and will not be candidates for degrees of their host institution. The number of students may be modified by mutual agreement to compensate for an imbalance in numbers in any given academic year during the term of this agreement.
2. Participating students will be proposed by their home institution on the basis of the following criteria which shall generally apply but may be deviated from in appropriate cases:
 - a. Good academic standing, as reflected by a 3.0 average or better in previous university academic work;
 - b. Appropriateness of program of study to be undertaken through the exchange program.
3. Each university agrees to appoint a Liaison Officer, who shall provide advisory and other academic services to students participating in the exchange under the terms of this agreement.
4. Both universities will make every reasonable effort to insure that university-approved accommodation is available to students participating under the terms of this exchange. The parties agree that if residence hall or other suitable university-approved accommodation is provided, it will be at a cost per student no greater than that charged to local

students attending the host institution. The cost of such housing shall be paid by the student as individuals.

5. Ewha Womans University agrees to waive in each academic year fees for up to two SUNY-SB students enrolling at Ewha under the terms of this agreement. SUNY-SB agrees that Ewha students enrolling at SUNY-SB on a non-degree basis shall be exempt from tuition in a number equal to the number of SUNY-SB students attending Ewha during the previous year; however, over the term of this agreement, it is understood that the total number of Ewha students will equal the number of SUNY-SB students participating in the exchange.
6. This agreement shall commence January 1, 1993, and shall continue for five years, subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement. Either party may terminate this agreement as of the end of any year period by giving at least six months notice.
