

**Memorandum of Understanding**

FOR

ACADEMIC COOPERATION

BETWEEN

Center for Ubiquitous Sensor Network Application Technology of Hanyang University

AND

College of Engineering and Applied Sciences, Stony Brook University

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between Center for Ubiquitous Sensor Network Application Technology of Hanyang University, Korea, hereinafter called "USNAT" and College of Engineering and Applied Sciences, Stony Brook University, hereinafter called "SBU-CEAS".

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, USNAT and SBU-CEAS, recognizing the value of educational, cultural and scientific collaborations between international universities, wish to establish an international academic cooperation in the field of science and technology.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants, conditions, and terms hereinafter set forth, and for other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

## ARTICLE I

- 1.1 It is the objective of this agreement to promote the international scientific collaboration for the benefit of academic education, training and research.
- 1.2 For this purpose the collaborating institutions will
- Exchange information necessary for educational and research activities
  - Encourage educational and research activities involving the other institutions
  - Conduct joint research and/or educational programs

## ARTICLE II

- 2.1 The exchange of academic materials will be done on a purely voluntary basis and will include such items as academic publications, pertinent research reports and holding of lectures. Neither institution is obliged to furnish specific documents or a predetermined quantity of documents to the other.
- 2.2 Both institutions are required to maintain confidentiality with respect to institutions or individuals not included in this agreement.
- 2.3 Both institutions shall develop specific mechanisms for the exchange faculty, researchers and students for implementing Article I. These shall be established and described in writing by authorized representatives of each institution prior to the initiation of any particular program or activity.
- 2.4 Commercialization of the results of research, patents arising there from and the share of benefits will be subject to negotiations between representatives from both institutes authorized to conduct such negotiations..

## ARTICLE III

- 3.1 Each party agrees to make good faith efforts to raise funds from various sources to fund cooperative programs developed in consideration of Articles I and II.

- 3.2 Any cooperative program developed under Articles I and II will be considered for implementation only after funds has been established to support said program.

#### ARTICLE IV

- 4.1.1. All activities and programs developed under the auspices of this Memorandum shall comply with the regulations, procedures and policies of each University as well as the law and regulations of the host country, including, by way of example only, intellectual property laws and applicable portions of the U.S. Export Controls Act.
- 4.2 The parties acknowledge that travel by faculty and students from one institution to the other are subject to the entry and visa regulations of the United States of America and Korea and insurance requirements of the host University.
- 4.1 To ensure the continued improvement and enrichment of the program, the parties agree that it shall be possible to introduce changes and additions to this Memorandum by means of mutually agreed upon additional written clauses subject to approval by authorized representatives at USNAT and CEAS-SBU. Either institution may terminate this contract, with or without a cause by giving six (6) month prior written notice to the other.

#### ARTICLE V

- 5.1 This agreement will be effective from the date of signing. It shall remain in force for a minimum period of five (5) years and shall be renewed by mutual agreement
- 5.1 This agreement is executed in two (2) counterparts in English language by authorized representatives of each institute. Each party will retain one counterpart thereof and each of the counterparts shall be deemed an original.

IN WITNESS OF THE ABOVE, the parties have caused this agreement to be executed by their respective duly authorized representatives as of the date below written.
