



AGREEMENT ON THE EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS
BETWEEN
THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
AND
KYOTO SANGYO UNIVERSITY

The State University of New York at Stony Brook and Kyoto Sangyo University agree to exchange students to promote education and cultural understanding in accordance with the following guidelines for the duration stated herein.

1. Exchange students will be enrolled at the State University of New York at the Stony Brook (SUNYSB) as non-matriculated students and at Kyoto Sangyo University (KSU) as non-degree auditor or non-degree research student.
2. The KSU students shall enroll in English courses offered by the Intensive English Center (IEC) at the SUNYSB during the summer. The specific arrangements will be in accordance with the Memorandum agreed on by the IEC and KSU and signed on September 15, 1998 and July 23, 1998, respectively.
3. The exchange students may audit courses at the host university. They may take courses or conduct research on special subjects provided by the host university in accordance with the academic regulations of faculties and the admission office of international exchange. The specific arrangements will be in accordance with the



ancillary Exchange Protocol signed by both universities.

4. The host university and institution will evaluate the student's performance in each course, issue the student's academic transcript, and send it to the counterpart institution. Credits earned at the host university may be transferable to the home institution in accordance with the academic regulations of the home institution.
5. Up to two students may be exchanged in any one academic year.
6. When the numbers of the exchange students are the same in one academic semester, tuition at the host universities will be mutually waived.
7. Tuition will be waived on a strictly reciprocal basis. When the number of exchange students sent by either university exceeds that of its counterpart, the party that exceeds in number of students will pay its counterpart the amount of tuition as required for the balance.
8. The period of enrollment of the exchange students will not exceed one academic year.
9. Both universities shall regularly contact and closely consult with each other for the exchange details.
10. The agreement shall be valid for a period of four (4) years from the date of signing, and thereafter it shall continue to be valid unless either party expresses in writing its intention to terminate the agreement.
