

Appendix I

FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF LEON (SPAIN) AND THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK (USA)

In order to further development of the Agreement undertaken between the Universities of Leon and Stony Brook (signed June 12, 1991), the universities agree to carry forward student exchanges for the period July 1993-January 1995, in accordance with the following

PROVISIONS

1. Each university will endeavor to send an equivalent number of students during the period of time encompassed by this Appendix. Equivalency shall be calculated on the bases of the number of months spent at the host university.
2. Each university will select the students it sends on exchange, based on mutual trust and the capabilities, performance and suitability of each student.
3. The students selected will have tuition charges waived, and will have full access to the host university's academic offerings, consistent with the university's norms regarding maximum enrollments.
4. Students participating in the exchange will be responsible for the costs of travel, maintenance, and medical and accident insurance required by the host university during the exchange period.
5. The host university will, subject to budgetary constraints, assume the housing costs for incoming exchange students. If the host university cannot cover these costs, it shall be the responsibility of the student to do so.

6. At the conclusion of the period covered by this Appendix, the universities shall prepare a report indicating expenses incurred and a list of students exchanged.

This Appendix shall be reviewed and updated at the end of the stipulated period. A decision to terminate by either party shall not prejudice any exchange already initiated, and students will be allowed to complete the exchange stay initially undertaken.
