

STUDENT EXCHANGE APPENDIX
to the
AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION
between the
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
and
SEOUL NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
The School of International and Area Studies

In accordance with Section II of the Agreement of Cooperation, the following mechanisms designed to encourage and facilitate exchange of students are hereby established:

1. Students are to be exchanged for the following period: Full academic year, fall semester only or spring semester only.
2. The number of students to be exchanged each year will be determined by mutual consent no later than April 15 of the preceding year. The universities agree to achieve full reciprocity, that is, to exchange an equal number of students by the end of this Agreement period [e.g. five years].
3. Initial selection of students will take place at the home institution; however, the host institution reserves the right to deny admission to any student not meeting its general admission criteria.
4. Student dossiers should be received at the host institution no later than May 15 for fall admissions and November 1 for spring admissions.
5. Each host university will secure on-campus accommodation for the incoming students comparable to that provided to the students of the host university. Students will be responsible for their own housing costs.
6. The host university will waive tuition charges for the incoming exchange students and will inform them in a timely fashion concerning fees and expenses for which the student will be responsible.
7. Students shall be responsible for obtaining health/insurance coverage to the satisfaction of the host university.
8. Students must be enrolled in a full-time course load at the host university for the duration of the program. At Stony Brook, this equals a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester (6 credits for each summer session).
9. Students will be free to choose courses from the full range of courses available at the hosting institution, provided they satisfy the individual course prerequisites and space is available.
10. Students must consult with international exchange office at the host institution before seeking any type of employment while participating in the exchange.
