Effective as of February 8, 2024, the undersigned Parties hereby agree to renew the Memorandum of Understanding and the Student Exchange Appendix (“Agreements”) between our institutions for an additional five (5) years (“Renewal Term”).

During the Renewal Term, the Parties agree to the following additions to the Agreements:

- The Agreements may be executed in two counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, and all of which, taken together, will constitute one and the same Agreements. It is understood that the Parties need not sign the same counterpart. Both counterparts shall be written in the English language.
- For the purposes of the Agreements, signatures transmitted by facsimile, Portable Document Format (PDF), or any other electronic means intended to preserve the original graphic and pictorial appearance of the Agreements will be deemed original signatures and will constitute effective execution of the Agreements sufficient to bind each Party. Photocopies of any such electronically transmitted signatures will be deemed the same.
