

AGREEMENT RENEWAL
between
STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK AT STONY BROOK
and
TOKYO UNIVERSITY OF FOREIGN STUDIES

Effective as of the date last signed below, the undersigned Parties hereby agree to renew the Memorandum of Understanding and its Student Exchange Appendix (“Agreements”) between the State University of New York at Stony Brook and Tokyo University of Foreign Studies for an additional five (5) years (“Renewal Term”).

During the Renewal Term, the parties agree to the following modifications in the Agreements:

[Memorandum of Understanding]

Article VI.3. A minimum period required to send a notice to terminate the MOU is changed from six months to twelve months.

Article V. The original clause is replaced by “Both institutions agree that any controversies, disputes or claims arising out of this MOU shall be settled by means of consensual negotiation.”

[Student Exchange Appendix]

Article 2. “Both institutions agree to exchange, in principle, up to 2 students every year.” is added to the original clause.

Article 3. Study Aboard Conditions are only applicable to SBU.

Article 5.2. The original clause is replaced by “Student dossiers from SBU should be received by TUFS no later than March 15 for fall admissions and November 15 for spring admissions.”

Article 8. The original statement, “Where reciprocity exists, the host university shall waive tuition cost for incoming students” is changed to “Where reciprocity exists, TUFS shall waive examination, entrance and tuition for SBU students and SBU shall waive tuition costs for TUFS students.”

Except as modified hereby, all terms, covenants and conditions of the Agreements shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and affirmed.
